Parents/Guardians,

The Oklahoma State Department of Education has announced an opportunity for students to participate in select testing opportunities for free during the fall semester of the 2021-2022 school year.

All Cyril 10th graders will take the PreACT on Sept 22. The test will be administered in a paper/pencil format during the school day.

Cyril will also offer the ACT (without writing) free of charge to any 10th, 11th, or 12th grade student who would like to participate. The test administration will take place on campus during the regular school day. The ACT will be administered on October 5, 2021, and will be administered in a paper/pencil format.

This ACT is a one-time testing opportunity and is optional. Parents should sign this form and return it if they do **not** want their students to be registered for the ACT by Cyril High School. Students that wish to participate will not need to register to test for this ACT test administration through their ACT portal. Test dates are set by ACT and College Board, and students are required to test on that specific date. Cyril High School will not be able to provide makeup sessions for students who are absent on the testing date.
